



Getting Connected with **Boingo**

Connect with the Boingo Wi-Finder App

The Boingo Wi-Finder app is available on PC, Mac, iOS, and Android, and it makes finding and connecting to hotspots easy worldwide. The app actively searches for hotspots and then provides notification to your device when a network has been detected. Best of all, the app enables you to log onto Boingo hotspots with just one click.

- 1 Download the app on your smartphone, tablet or laptop at www.boingo.com/boingo-apps/
- 2 Log into the app using your Boingo username and password.
- 3 The app will automatically provide notification when you are within range of a Boingo hotspot.
- 4 Select “connect” from the app. Now you’re online!

Connect *without* the Boingo Wi-Finder App

The Boingo Wi-Finder app is the easiest way to get connected to Boingo hotspots, but you can also connect manually through your browser with a few simple steps.

- 1 From the Wi-Fi menu on your device, select and connect to the Boingo hotspot or a Boingo partner from the network list. Note: Partner hotspots may not have the name “Boingo” in them. Visit <http://wifi.boingo.com> to find hotspots available near you.
- 2 Launch your Internet browser. A landing page will load, prompting you to log in. Note: If you regularly use a VPN—on a work computer, for example—you may need to deactivate the proxy server settings in order to see this landing page. The exact location of this setting can vary by browser, but it’s usually found within Internet Options>Connections>LAN Settings. Then uncheck “Use proxy server.”
- 3 Log in using your Boingo username and password. Now you’re online! Note: If logging into a partner hotspot, you may need to first select “roaming partner login,” or something similar, and then select “Boingo.”
